TelAlaska to Offer High-Speed Internet Service in Galena

High-speed *digital subscriber line* (DSL) Internet service from TelAlaska's Arctic.net will be available in Galena November 13.

The company will offer four packages of DSL service in Galena: a \$29.95 *Light* option for the occasional user, the \$45.95 *Bright* high-speed service that meets the demands of the average user, the \$79.95 *Xtra-Bright* high-speed service for the heavy user, and *Business Right*, a higher-speed package for businesses for \$89.95 per month. Managed service, intended mostly for business users, is priced from \$187 per month for 128K to \$540 per month for 512K.

DSL service is always-on, which means customers don't need to dial in and wait to retrieve e-mails and surf the web. The service also doesn't tie up the phone line, allowing customers to use the phone and Internet simultaneously.
